

Lent is Coming!

The season of Lent, the six-week long season that leads us to Easter, begins this year on Wednesday, March 5 (Ash Wednesday). That's over a month away, but it isn't too early for you to make plans to have a great Easter. This year at Cannon, we'll get ready for Easter by walking with Jesus through the Gospel of John. There are three ways for you to be part of this journey.

- First, read John's Gospel. As in previous years, we'll have a 40-day reading plan to guide us through the Gospel. In addition, to help us get the most out of our reading, Pastor Tim will lead a class called "How to Read John" on Sunday, February 23 at 9:30am in the fellowship hall. (For those who can't make it, a recording of the class will be posted online.)
- Second, study John's Gospel. On the Sundays in Lent, Pastor Tim will lead a Sunday School class using *The Gospel of John: A Beginner's Guide to the Way, the Truth, and the Life* by Amy-Jill Levine, a Jewish New Testament Scholar at Vanderbilt University. This will be a great class. More info coming soon!
- Third, meet the people Jesus loved! On the Sundays in Lent, we'll meet the people Jesus loved in the Gospel of John. In contrast Matthew, Mark, and Luke, where Jesus most often engages large crowds, John tells stories about Jesus engaging with individuals: a woman by a well, a rabbi at night, a paralyzed man, a women caught in adultery, a man born blind, a disciple who doubted, and one who failed. As we meet these people, the people Jesus loved, we'll experience Christ's love for us today.

We hope you will join us, starting Wednesday, March 5, as we get ready for Easter by walking with Jesus through the Gospel of John. We would love to share this journey with you!








